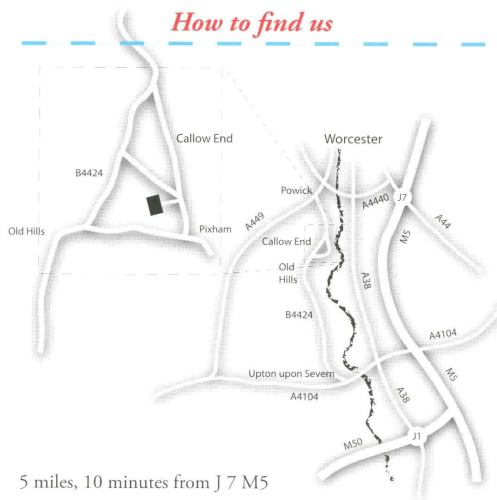

How to find us



5 miles, 10 minutes from J 7 M5

Exit J7 M5 heading towards Worcester on A44. At first island,
turn left onto A440 towards Malvern.

Straight over 2 islands and over new bridge over River Severn, then left at
next island onto A449.

Take first left (B4424), signed to Upton-upon-Severn. Past Blue Bell public
house on right, take the left fork as the main road curves to the right in
front of the village shop. You are now in Lower Ferry Lane.

Priors Court entrance is on the right, immediately after the Horse Warning
Triangle and Speed De-restriction sign.

8 miles, 15 minutes from J1 M50

Coming from the South on the M5, turn onto M50. Exit at Junction 1 and
follow A38 north (to Worcester).

Turn left onto A4104, over River Bridge at Upton and turn right at mini
island onto B4211 for 3 miles.

After passing The Old Hills (open public space) on left, as the main road
curves left, turn right (on the curve) into a narrow lane. It has a discreet
finger sign pointing to Pixham. Take first left, and you are now in Lower
Ferry Lane.

The entrance to Priors Court is on the left immediately before the 30 mph sign.
